To Whom it May Concern,

In reference to the manufacturer's suggested cleaning guidelines for Dr. Brown's Medical products, please note a difference in suggested cleaning requirements when used in a hospital or clinical environment.

Handi-Craft Company, the manufacturer of the Dr. Brown's products, has suggested cleaning guidelines for products purchased in retail, and intended for home use, that include boiling for 5 mins prior to first use. It is understood this is not a practical cleaning option for hospital use, therefore an equally suitable cleaning option for hospital use has been included in the attached document.

Dr. Brown's® Zero-Resistance™ Bottle Systems, including the nipple, are reusable and not intended as a disposable product. The Dr. Brown's Medical team has taken into consideration the hospital/clinical environment and the ability to provide adequate cleaning of the Dr. Brown's® products prior to first use and/or after each use. In an effort to provide adequate cleaning guidelines based on suggestions by the American Dietetic Association¹, *reusable feeding products should be cleaned with soap and water and sanitized prior to first use*; cleaned with soap and water immediately after each use; allowed to air dry; and recommended to sanitize/sterilize at least once every 24 hours. ALL recommendations provided in these documents, are intended to be used as a guideline for supporting individual hospital cleaning requirements and/or infection control policies and protocols.
