

Instructions for Using the Dr. Brown's® Microwave Steam Sanitizing Bags

- 1. Clean and rinse all items as recommended in the Dr. Brown's Medical Manufacturer Suggested Guidelines for Hospital and Clinical Environments.
- 2. Place clean and rinsed product parts in the Microwave Steam Sanitizing bag. Make sure all parts are disassembled. Do not overfill steam bag with parts.
- 3. Add 2oz/60 mL of water to the microwave steam bag.

 IMPORTANT NOTE Using less than the appropriate amount of water could distort the shape of the products.
- 4. Seal bag tightly.
- 5. Put bag with products inside, into microwave oven on center of turntable.
- 6. Microwave on High Power per the time chart below:
 - 1.5 Minutes for 1100 W+
 - 3 Minutes for 800 1100 W
 - 5 Minutes for 500 750 W
- 7. Using an oven mitt or potholder, carefully remove the bag from the microwave.

 WARNING: Be careful as steam and water will be very hot. Avoid touching the Drain Spout (indicated in RED) on the microwave steam bag.
- 8. Cool 10 minutes.
- 9. Use Drain Spout to pour out excess water before removing the sanitized parts.

 NOTE: Each Dr. Brown's Microwave Steam Bag can be used for a total of 30 cycles.

WARNING – SAFETY NOTE

- Be careful when removing bag from microwave as water and steam will be very hot.
- Only sanitize parts deemed safe for microwaves.
- Steam bag is intended only for plastics that are microwave safe.
- Do not place the steam bag in a conventional oven.
- Do not place the steam bag on the metallic grill in some microwaves.
- Be sure to follow the time chart as heating longer than the recommended time may distort shape of parts.
